Are you like this?

Every now and then, I try to become a list maker. Usually, it's this time of the year, when I hope that I can be different whispers a little louder than my poor track record. I do love you. I have from the beginning, and always will love you. And love, at the top of the list, covers up a multitude of the rusty dings. Thank you for loving us this way.




